

Elephant Rocks and Elephant Cove - Western Australia

A little break away from it all!

At the heart of William Bay National Park, is this lovely, remote site with its interesting rock formations. You can leave your motorhome in the parking area and easily go down to the beach and enjoy the sun and clear turquoise sea.

Elephant Cove, just 15 km from [Denmark](#), is characterised by coves with big rocks that have, over time, come to resemble a herd of elephants. These large rocks form lovely, turquoise-green pools of water that are ideal for children to swim in. The
