Petrol and service stations in Canada

In general fuel is **much less expensive** (on average two times cheaper) in Canada than in Europe. But the price can change quickly. More **rural service stations** tend to be more expensive than those in the cities. Also, fill up with fuel at the beginning of the week as from Thursday the prices increase.

Always **check the total fuel tank capacity** of your vehicle before departing on a long journey, as often the service stations are quite far apart.

As of July 3rd 2020, the average world gasoline price is **US\$1.247/litre** and the average cost of diesel is **US\$1.059/litre**. These prices are only an average. The price therefore varies greatly over time and from one region to another!

Favour **rural stations** which will be cheaper than in the city.
