Explore the Gaspésie National Park in your motorhome

Located in the Gulf of Saint Lawrence, Gaspésie National Park offers spectacular scenery, a maritime climate and many attractions. Fish and seafood lovers will appreciate this region.

Depart from Montreal in your motorhome and explore the Gaspé region including Gaspésie National Park. Follow the famous Route 132 along the coast. You'll have no trouble finding campsites along the way.

Gaspésie National Park is an ideal place for nature lovers. Enjoy the Canadian wildlife, especially the caribou. This park has two mountain peaks, the Chic-Choc and the McGerrigle with the famous Mont Jacques-Cartier. Hiking the Mont Jacques-Cartier and Mont Albert will allow you to fully appreciate the spectacular mountain scenery. You can also try your hand at fishing to catch some trout or salmon.

The park has a gourmet restaurant and a nature interpretation centre. You can also enjoy some canoeing, hiking or mountain biking. When following the Mont Chic-Chos trails or climbing the 1270 meters of Mont Jacques-Cartier you will see that the vegetation is similar to that found in the Far North.
