#### FAQ – RV Rental Toronto

**Do I need a special license to drive a motorhome in Ontario?** No, a standard car driver's license is valid for all rental motorhomes and campervans in Canada.

**Can I visit Niagara Falls with a rental motorhome?** Yes, Niagara Falls is just 1.5 hours from Toronto and has RV?friendly campgrounds nearby. The best view is from the Canadian side!

What is the best season for a road trip from Toronto? From May to October, with September–October offering spectacular fall colors.

**Are Ontario campgrounds equipped for motorhomes?** Yes. Most campgrounds offer electricity, water, and dump stations. Provincial and national parks provide modern facilities.

Can I rent one?way from Toronto to another city? Yes. Popular routes include Toronto–Montreal, Toronto–Halifax, and Toronto–Vancouver. For you adventurous souls trans-canada cross country trips can be organised far in advance.
