Discover the best time to explore Ireland depending on the weather.

Ireland's climate is oceanic and temperate. The most pleasant months to visit this country are spring and summer. The maximum temperature in summer is 28 degrees. Indeed, it is not impossible to travel in Ireland in winter, but unpleasant weather conditions such as wind or rain may disturb you during your hikes.
