Located in east central Poland, Warsaw is the Capital city of Poland. This dynamic European metropolis boasts the most skyscrapers in Europe. Stroll through historic old town you will discover architecture out of a Canaletto painting, the old town was painstakingly rebuilt after world war II from paintings by the master and is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Away from the crowds on the waterfront of the Vistula river, and visit the mini beach and observation desks. The locals are proud of their title as the culinary capital of Poland, with “milk bars” from communist times, food trucks and Michelin starred restaurants. Savour a plate of pierogi dumplings, originally food of the peasants, these delicious stuffed dumplings have become a favorite delicacy of Poland.
