The park is also home to a large bird population, best observed during and after the rainy season.

A 4x4 is the ideal method to tour the park. It is the only method of transport that offers you access to the entire park, as there are zones that are impossible to access without a 4X4 vehicle. The park is also known for its famous hiking trails.
