Hwange National Park lies to the west of the country covering over 14 km² and is home to the greatest concentration of animals since 1970. Since its creation as a national park in 1928 more than 60 artificial water points have been created within the park.

Hwange National Park has a hundred species of mammals and 450 different bird species making it one of the best, if not the best, **wildlife reserves in the country**. The landscapes are exceptional and very varied from **Kalahari** sand areas to **savannah landscapes** and salt marshes.

You won't leave without seeing the famous **Big Five** (elephant, lion, buffalo, leopard and rhinoceros) and many other animals such as giraffe, antelope, hyenas, baboons, impala, springbok and zebra.

A **4x4 vehicle** will allow you easy and enjoyable access with **total independence**.
