- Camping:
 - Wild camping is restricted use official **campsites** (over 200 across the country).
 - Many offer showers, kitchens, and laundry facilities.
- Driving:
 - The Ring Road is paved, but highland F?roads require 4x4 and are only open in summer.
 - Weather changes fast always check road conditions.
