No — a valid car driver's license is sufficient. An **International Driving Permit (IDP)** is recommended as an official translation, but it is not mandatory.

Which type of motorhome should I choose for a U.S. road trip?

A Campervan (Class B RV) is ideal for 2 travelers, a **Class C RV** is the ideal motorhome for families and the **Class A Motorhome** is king for premium comfort and space. If you are unsure our travel experts are here to help.

What is the best time of year for a motorhome trip in the USA?

- Spring (March May): Perfect for California's coast (Highway 1), Utah's national parks, and Texas wildflowers.
- Summer (June August): Best for exploring the national parks of the American West Yellowstone, Yosemite, Glacier, and the Rockies.
- Fall (September November): Ideal for New England foliage, the Blue Ridge Parkway, and Southwest desert landscapes in cooler weather.
