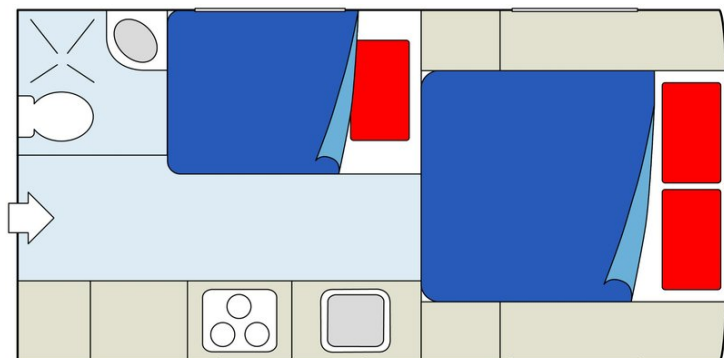
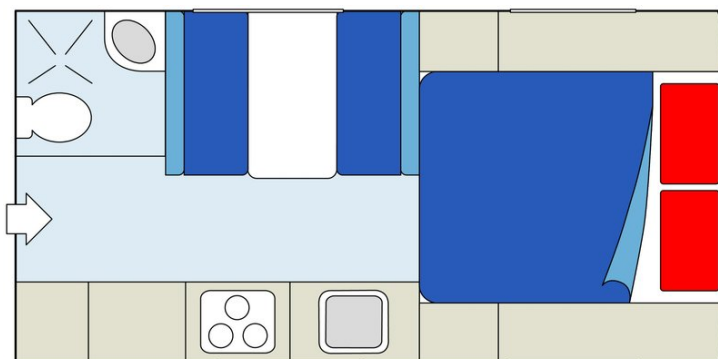


# Truck Camper Wapiti Truck pick-up Canada

Description	The <b>Wapiti Truck Pick-up</b> is a unique RV: a <b>rugged 4x4 truck</b> with a camper offering a <b>queen bed</b> , <b>convertible dinette</b> , <b>equipped kitchen</b> and <b>private bathroom</b> . Perfect for exploring Canada off the beaten path.

Kitchen	<b>3-burner propane stove</b> <b>Microwave</b> <b>Fridge freezer 178 L (6.3 cu ft)</b> <b>Hot/cold sink</b> A well-equipped kitchen for meals on the road.
Shower/Toilet	Bathroom with <b>shower, toilet, sink</b> All the comfort of an RV combined with the agility of a truck camper.
Heating/Air Conditionning	<b>Propane furnace</b> (operates even when parked with 110V) Dash A/C while driving Roof A/C when parked on <b>110 V shore power</b> Simple and effective comfort all year.
Energy	<b>12/110 V power</b> <b>Dual battery</b> <b>Solar panel</b> (keeps batteries charged for lights, pump, USB) Enhanced autonomy between hookups.
Audio & Connexions	<b>Radio</b> <b>USB and AUX ports</b> The essentials for music and device charging.
Complementary Equipment	<b>No internal walkthrough</b> <b>Practical storage</b> <b>Fire extinguisher</b> Simple, robust features for adventure.
