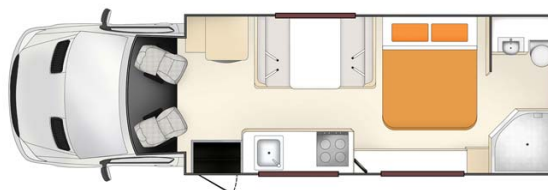


# Motorhome Wombat Slider Australia

Energy	<b>Gas.</b> Allows operation of the refrigerator, water heater and heater when the vehicle is not connected to the mains. 1 x 4.5 kg, 1 x 2 kg (from April 1st 2020: 2 x 4.5kg) <b>240V "hook up" connection</b> <b>Auxiliary battery.</b> Allows to operate the lights. It has an autonomy of about 12 hours and is recharged while driving or being connected to 240V. <b>Cigar lighter.</b> Remember to take adapters to recharge small electrical appliances such as telephones or cameras.
