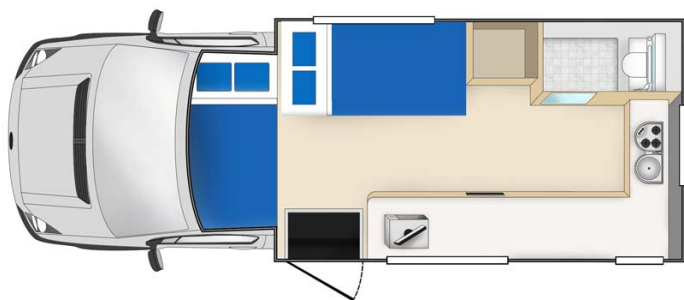
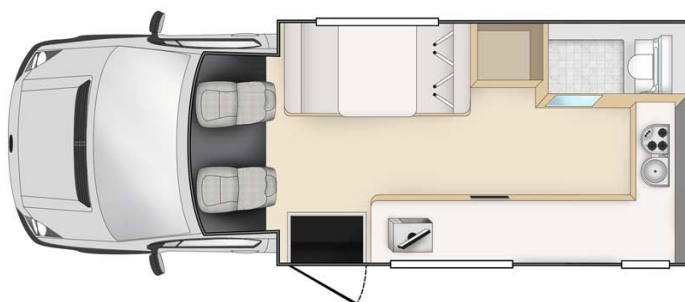

Heating/Air Conditionning	Heating/Air conditioning driving: like in a car Heating/Air conditioning stopped: by 240V electrical connexion or by gas
Energy	Gas. Allows operation of the refrigerator, water heater and heater when the vehicle is not connected to the mains. 240V "hook up" connection Auxiliary battery. Allows to operate the lights. It has an autonomy of about 12 hours and is recharged while driving or being connected to 240V. Cigar lighter. Remember to take adapters to recharge small electrical appliances such as telephones or cameras.
