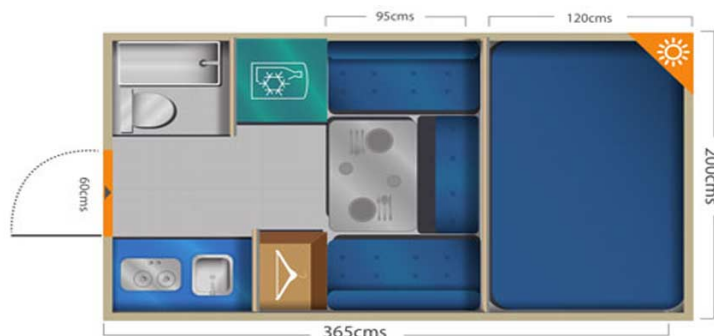


4wd Patagonia Camper Chile
